- All kids programs have limited enrollment and most sessions fill up prior to Registration Deadlines. Don't delay, sign up today!
- All kids programs have minimum age requirements; proof of age in the form of a birth certificate may be required.
- Some kids programs require a minimum skill level; please refer to Skill Levels below for description.
- In the event you are unable to attend a session date, there are no make-ups or credits given for any reason.
- If Ski Sundown cancels a session date due to unfavorable weather conditions, a make-up will be offered or a voucher will be issued for a session visit comparable to the program purchased.
- A confirmation letter will be mailed prior to the start of the program.
- A Program Badge is issued for the entire program. If it is forgotten on any of the program's session dates, a Replacement Ticket good for one visit must be purchased at the Welcome Center for \$5.00. Lost Program Badges will be replaced for a \$5.00 fee. The purchase price of a Replacement Ticket may not be applied towards the cost of a Program Badge replacement.
- Program Refund Policy:
 - A full refund less a \$25 administrative fee will be given if request is made in writing and received prior to the program Registration Deadline.
 - No refund will be given after the program Registration Deadline for any reason unless the Program Protection Policy has been purchased.
 - All requests for refunds must be received by the Welcome Center prior to the end of the season.

1

Riding chair lift and can ski independently making wedge turns on **easiest beginner terrain**

level
2

Can ski in wedge confidently on **all beginner terrain**

level
3

Exploring **intermediate terrain** using wedge and beginning parallel turns

level
4

Confidently skis **all intermediate and easier advanced terrain** making parallel turns

level
5

Making consistent parallel turns on **groomed advanced terrain** and ready to explore moguls, steeper terrain and variable snow conditions

level
6

snowboarding

First time on a snowboard

Can control speed and direction but has not ridden a chair lift with a snowboard

Riding a chair lift and can control snowboard on **beginner terrain**

Beginning to link turns and beginning to ride on **intermediate terrain**

Can comfortably link turns on **all intermediate terrain** and beginning to ride **easier advanced terrain**

Can comfortably ride **all mountain terrain** and learning advanced techniques (180's, switch riding and carving)
