

program notes

what you need to know

- Attendance at the first week's lesson is mandatory for both Children's & Adult Programs.
- All Children's programs have minimum age requirements; proof of age in the form of a birth certificate may be required.
- Some Children's programs require a minimum skill level; please refer to **Skill Levels** below for description.
- All Children's programs have limited enrollment and some sessions fill up prior to Registration Deadlines. Don't delay, sign up today!
- There are no make-ups or credits given for missed session dates.
- A Program Pass is issued for the entire program. If it is forgotten on any of the program's sessions dates, a temporary pass good for one visit must be purchased at the Welcome Center for \$5.00. Lost program passes can be replaced for a \$10.00 fee. The purchase price of a temporary pass may not be applied towards the cost of a replacement pass.
- If Ski Sundown cancels a session date due to unfavorable weather conditions a make-up date will be offered or a voucher will be issued for a session visit comparable to the program purchased.
- Program changes are accepted up to 48 hours prior to the start of a program and are subject to a \$25 administrative fee.
- Program Refund Policy:
 - A full cash refund less a \$25 administrative fee will be given if request is made in writing and received 48 hours or more prior to the program Registration Deadline.
 - No refunds or credits will be given after the program Registration Deadline for any reason unless the Program Protection Policy is purchased and are subject to the provisions outlined in the Program Protection Policy. (See Program Application)
- Program Protection Policy must be purchased at the time the program is purchased and costs 5% of the Total Due for Program per individual.

Can ski in control with linked wedge turns and can stop on easy terrain. Can ride a chairlift.

■

Can ski in control with linked wedge turns. Can stop with a parallel skidded finish.

◆

Can ski parallel confidently on more challenging terrain.



snowboarding skill levels

new → learning → advanced → skilled →

●

First time on a snowboard - cannot ride a chairlift.

●

Can make direction changes on both the heel and toe edges. Can perform the "falling leaf". Can stop on easy groomed terrain. Ready to ride, or can ride a chairlift.

■

Can link skidded heel and toe turns on intermediate terrain. Can link skidded "switch" turns on easy groomed terrain.

◆

Can link carved turns on most terrain. Can link skidded "switch" turns on moderate terrain.
